Where and When:

- Please be at Angela Coughlan Pool (Guelph line & Upper middle Rd), by 7:30 pm on each Thursday. Classroom sessions start promptly at 7:30 followed by a pool session at 9pm.
- Before first night we will cover registration, medicals and basic equipment at the shop. 1st Class room session will start right into programing. Pool session will cover a swim test with laps and treading water as well as some snorkeling basics. So please bring swimsuit, towel, mask fins and snorkel.
- Medical forms and Registration forms can be downloaded from the web site and encourage you to have these complete in advance. You can also find course standards documentation to assist in your research.
- Students are required to have their own basic equipment: Mask, fins, snorkel and weight belt with 6lbs of lead. You are highly encouraged to borrow or purchase these, as they can be used for snorkeling and normal swimming, Average cost is \$150.00.
